- **Focus Appearance:** We've enhanced the visibility of focus indicators, as per WCAG 2.2 guidelines, to ensure users can easily identify interactive elements when navigating by keyboard.
- **Drag-and-Drop Alternatives:** Any drag-and-drop functionality includes alternative methods of interaction, allowing users to achieve the same tasks without needing to use a mouse.
